## PRODUCTION STARTS AT SAINT-EUSÈBE!



This new site devoted to refrigerated utility vehicles, the establishment of which was made official at the Solutrans Trade Fair in November 2015, began the assembly of refrigerated vans at the beginning of April ahead of the initial planning.

This line is the first to begin production, one of the five which will be established on this site in the long term: assembly of refrigerated vans, production of integrated insulation kits, production of panel moulds for the integrated insulation, assembly of refrigerated bodies, and manufacture of insulation panels for the refrigerated bodies.

At the same time as its start-up, this business also obtained its quality certification, ISO 9001 Version 2008.

With the current build-up, 30 direct jobs will have been created within this establishment by the end of 2016, with only 25% of the industrial process in place in this period.

When full capacity is established the activity will have 150 direct jobs and 50 indirect jobs.
